APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The ANAR 117 course is open to all students, with instructor's approval. Enrollment is limited, and applications will be accepted until the program fills. This course requires travel to the La Posta Reservation, near Campo, CA, three times weekly.

- 1. Complete the online application
- 2. Meet for a brief interview with professor for approval to register
- 3. Provisionally accepted students must meet additional requirements before class starts: (program fee, Physician's form, Emergency contacts, proof of insurance, and waiver).

Students registered for ANAR 117 pay for eight regular UCSD credits and fees, and a program fee of \$480 for instructional costs.

FINANCIAL AID: Financial aid is available for qualified UCSD students. Aid is limited and will be awarded on a first come first served basis. Scholarships for undergraduate research are available through the UCSD International Center and the various colleges.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Field archaeology in the desert can be strenuous. Students must submit a physician's certificate, proof of insurance, and waiver after provisional acceptance to the program.
